Worship

English Worship Service



Our English Worship
Services continue to be

This year, Pastor Ivan preached through three sermon series during the English Worship Service:

• February to March - "Under the Care of God's Providence" — A series through the Book of Ruth. God's providence means that God has not abandoned the world that He created. But rather, He works and has control within that creation to manage all things according to His will. He is involved in your life, even though you sometimes may feel He is not there. He is God who sees and hears, because He is God who cares. In the Book of Ruth, we see how God providentially worked in the lives of Naomi and Ruth to

care and provide for them. He provided for them rest (temporary physical needs) and redemption (eternal salvation). (https://goo.gl/dytHBk)

- April to May "The Restoring Power of Forgiveness" A four-part series about forgiveness. Forgiveness is the cancelation of a debt. It is the release or dismissal of something owed. Because of sin, our vertical relationship with God and horizontal relationship with others are marred. But through the power of forgiveness, our relationships can be restored. (https://goo.gl/4ByoJy)
- September to December "Wisdom from Above" A series through the Book of James. James shares wisdom from God, concerning how we can be devoted and loyal to Him in many practical areas of our faith and life. (https://goo.gl/3YLRFJ)

Education

Junior High Sunday School

This year's Junior High Sunday School have been taught by Caiyun Chen, Zhaolin Cheng, Min Li, Bei Liu, Mingfu Wu and Tracy Zhang. We continued using the Regular Baptist Press' curriculum. The 20+ students have been divided into two classes covered the following topics:

- January to May: "My Life, My World, God's Answers" Equipping students in applying Biblical truth in real life issues.
- May to September: "Elijah and Elisha: Guided by God" Teaching students how to follow and serve God.
- September to December: "Essential Biblical Truth" Providing a systematic review of fundamental doctrines.

Our current curriculum is a three-year cycle studying Biblical characters and essential doctrines based on God's Word, and especially teaching students how to apply the Biblical truth in their lives. Discussions with their peers in the classroom setting provide a loving and supportive environment to encourage them to grow together and serve one another in Christ, which is very important for this age group. It is our desire and prayer that the parents will encourage and help their youth to be faithful in attending Sunday school, so they can be set on a path toward growing in their faith, knowledge and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ!

High School, College, and Young Adult Sunday School

Like last year, high school students, college students, and young adults continued to have Sunday School classes together. We covered the following topics this year:

• Spring Semester – **World Religions** (Pastor Ivan)

From January to June, we learned about various world religions including Roman Catholicism, Judaism, Mormonism, Jehovah's Witnesses, Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Atheism/Secular Humanism, Confucianism, Taoism, New Age, and Scientology. We covered the origins of these religions, their beliefs and doctrines in comparison to Christian doctrine, and effective ways to evangelize to people of these religions. Students volunteered in groups to do research and present about each of these religions.

• Summer – Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, John (Joyce Tseng)

During the Summer, we compared the accounts of the four Gospels and learned about the chronological order of events. In doing so, we reviewed Jesus' life and ministry including His birth, preparation for ministry, calling of His Disciples, teachings, and interactions with the Pharisees.

• Fall Semester – **Discipleship and Spiritual Formation** (Pastor Ivan)

From September to December, we tried a new format for Sunday School. Part of the class consisted of a lecture concerning being a disciple of Jesus Christ and growing in our relationship with Him. The second part of the class was a time for the students to meet in a small group that they stayed with for the whole semester to disciple one another. This was the first time in the history of the CCCGA Scripture Memory Competition that both teams recited all of the main verses of the round correctly. This led to

the "Tiebreaker Round". When each time recited their five verses correctly as well, we had to enter the "Sudden Death Round" which involved correctly identifying the reference of a verse

read out by the Master Questioner. In the end Paul's team consisting of Edward Lo, Hannah Eng, Joshua Wang, and Caleb Zhang pulled through and became the 2018 Scripture Memory Champions! Thank you to Pastor Phil Woodrow for always organizing these competitions!
