## 2019-2020 Hospitality Team Application Form - ADULT

The purpose of the CCCGA Hospitality Team is to glorify God by welcoming members of the congregation to the English Worship Service and lead them to worship God through prayer and offering. Members on the Hospitality Team can serve as a presider or usher, under the leadership of the Hospitality Team Coordinator.

The Hospitality Team is a ministry open to those youth and adults of our church who have professed the faith in our Lord Jesus Christ and hold themselves accountable to one another as they seek to maintain high spiritual standards. Therefore, if you wish to apply for membership on the Hospitality Team, there are a number of questions that first must be answered:

## **5 Questions to Answer**

- 1.) Do I know Christ as my personal Savior and desire to serve Him as Lord of my life?
- 2.) Do I seek to live in a way that honors the Father?
- 3.) Do I desire a consistent quiet time with my Lord?
- 4.) Do I believe/sense the Spirit's call for me to serve on this year's Hospitality Team?
- 5.) Am I able to commit my time to serve in this ministry during monthly meetings and Sunday worship services while balancing my other responsibilities including studies, work, or family?

If you are able to respond "yes" to each of those questions, please consider the next step involving Hospitality Team Membership.

### 5 Membership Responsibilities

If given the opportunity to serve as a presider or usher on the Hospitality Team, I am prepared to

- 1.) Attend the training and informational session in September/January.
- 2.) Attend Hospitality Team meetings on the last Sunday of each month during lunch for the purpose of fellowship, sharing, prayer, and scheduling of roles for each Sunday of the following month.
- 3.) Arrive at church no later than 10:45 AM each Sunday morning to prepare to set up and lead in my assigned role.
- 4.) Work and cooperate fully with the appointed Hospitality Team Leadership.
- 5.) Maintain a humble attitude that seeks unity and helpful collaboration within the team.

If you agree with and are prepared to accept these responsibilities, the final step is your willingness to abide by the following standards:

# **5 Standards of Hospitality Team**

1.)	1.) Membership on the CCCGA Hospitality Team for adults requires a <b>Fall and/or Spring c</b> coincide with the beginning and end of each college semester:

2.)	Finding transportation to and from each monthly Saturday meeting and Sunday worship service will be the responsibility of each member. If necessary, carpool can be arranged with other members.			
3.)	3.) It is assumed that every member is available each week to serve. However, if there is an unavoidable conflict that prevents any member from attending a Sunday Worship Service, he/she must communicate with the Hospitality Team Coordinator as soon as possible, at least a week in advance, but preferably during the monthly meeting.			
4.)	If attendance to any of the Hospitality Team functions or non-compliance to other responsibilities becomes a problem, the Hospitality Team Coordinator may notify the individual that his/her membership has been suspended for an indefinite period of time.			
5.)	5.) Having reviewed the above requirements, prayed about possible involvement in this ministry, discussed it with your parents, and are interested in being considered for membership for the coming year, both the applicant and his/her parent must complete, sign this application, and hand it to David Lin by <b>Sunday September 22</b> (Fall commitment) or <b>Sunday January 12</b> . (Spring commitment)
